KITTY CARE



Kitten primary care at Value Pet Vet focuses on providing comprehensive health services to ensure your kitten's healthy growth and development. It includes essential services such as vaccinations, parasite prevention, nutritional counseling, and regular wellness exams to monitor your kitten's overall health. Early primary care also involves screening for common congenital or genetic conditions, as well as guidance on behavior, training (especially litter box training) and socialization to set your kitten up for a healthy and happy life. Regular check-ups are crucial to detect any potential health issues early, allowing for prompt treatment and ongoing support to keep your kitten thriving.

Primary kitten care at Value Pet Vet Includes:

- **Vaccinations:** Vaccines are crucial to protect your kitten from common and potentially deadly diseases such as feline distemper, feline leukemia, and upper respiratory infections.
- **Parasite Prevention:** Kittens are prone to parasites like fleas, ticks, & worms. Regular treatments and preventative measures help keep your kitten safe from these pests.
- **Nutritional Counseling:** Proper nutrition is vital for your kitten's growth. A veterinarian can provide guidance on the best diet, portion sizes, and feeding schedules to ensure your kitten gets the right nutrients.
- **Wellness Exams:** Routine vet visits help monitor your kitten's health, growth, and development. These exams can detect health issues early, allowing for timely treatment.
- **Behavior and Socialization Guidance:** Early guidance on behavior, litter training, and socialization helps your kitten develop into a well-adjusted adult cat. This includes tips on introducing your kitten to new environments, people, and other pets.
- **Spaying or Neutering:** Discussing the right time to spay or neuter your kitten is an essential part of primary care, helping to prevent unwanted litters and reduce the risk of certain health problems later in life.

Before Booking Your Appointment

Before Booking: You are responsible for understanding all costs involved with your pet's procedure. Many of the costs listed are base line, we have requirements for added pain management and antibiotics after surgeries. All pets must also have an E Collar (cone) to go home. Lastly, if your pet is female, there are additional costs involved with a spay.

Deposits Required When Booking:

We require deposits FOR ALL ANESTHETIC PROCEDURES (spay/neuter, dentals and other surgeries) when booking your pet's appointment with us. Please scroll down to the anesthetic procedure you are booking for to see the required deposit. All deposits are NON REFUNDABLE! You may reschedule the appointment with at least 24 hours notice but you may NOT cancel the booking altogether. If you cancel your appointment outside of these guidelines/restrictions, then the deposit will be forfeited. ALL FORFEITED DEPOSITS ARE REDIRECTED TO OUR 501c, THE NANCY ANIMAL WELFARE FUND. Please understand, last minute cancellations have a negative impact on our clinic logistics, efficiency and proper staffing, as well as on our limited surgical slots available to the public. We ask that you give sufficient thought prior to scheduling your pet's anesthetic procedure to avoid deposit forfeiture. We value your business and trust in our services, and would rather focus our energy on providing you with the very best care for your loved pets than dealing with retained deposits!

If you are unsure what the total cost of your pets visit will be, please reach out to an employee BEFORE booking to understand the costs. No refunds will be issued because, by booking an appointment with us, you have agreed that you understand the charges involved with your pets appointment.
